



Stability Information (Shelf Life)

If gelatin is stored in a tightly sealed poly-lined container in normal indoor conditions, it will remain stable indefinitely.

It can be re-tested annually to insure that it has maintained its integrity.

The only exception would be if the gelatin was kept in a heated space above 113°F (45°C) with relatively high humidity (above 60% RH). In this extreme scenario, the gelatin would gradually lose its ability to swell and dissolve.

If an expiration date were required, we would list 3 years from the date of manufacture.
